AMENDED GENERAL ORDER NO. 11-1

REGARDING MATTERS INVOLVING THE
SPRINGER BROWN FIRM IN DU PAGE COUNTY
TO BE HEARD IN JOLIET, IL THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2011

Effective January 13, 2011

General Order 11-1, issued January 7, 2011, is hereby amended as follows:

WHEREAS, Judge John H Squires has announced that he is retiring from the bench as of January 1, 2012 and will join the law firm of Springer, Brown, Covey, Gaertner and Davis, LLC (“Springer Brown firm”) as “of counsel” after he retires,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all matters in DuPage County in which the Springer Brown firm or any lawyer affiliated with the Springer Brown firm is a party in interest or represents a party in interest (collectively “Springer Brown matters”) will be heard in Joliet, Illinois by Judge Bruce W. Black beginning Friday, January 14, 2011 and continuing until December 31, 2011.

In order to permit counsel in DuPage County cases to schedule Springer Brown matters more efficiently, except for emergencies covered by paragraph 9 of this order, all Springer Brown matters for DuPage County cases will be heard by Judge Black in Joliet on the **Third Friday of each month** as follows:

1. New Chapter 7 Matters: All new chapter 7 Springer Brown matters must be noticed for 9:00 a.m. on the third Friday of each month in Joliet.
2. Continued or Set Chapter 7 Matters: All continued or set chapter 7 Springer

Brown matters will be heard at 9:00 a.m. on the third Friday of each month in Joliet.

3. New Chapter 12 and 13 Matters: All new chapter 12 and chapter 13 Springer Brown matters must be noticed for 9:59 a.m. on the third Friday of each month in Joliet.
4. Continued or Set Chapter 12 and 13 Matters and Confirmation Hearings:
All continued or set chapter 12 and chapter 13 Springer Brown matters and confirmation hearings will be heard at 10:59 a.m. on the third Friday of each month in Joliet.
5. Matters Previously Scheduled for the Third Friday of the Month in DuPage:
All Springer Brown matters previously scheduled for the third Friday of each month will be heard on that date at the times set forth above in Joliet.
6. Matters Previously Scheduled for Other Dates: All Springer Brown matters previously scheduled for dates other than the third Friday of each month will be heard in Joliet on the third Friday following the date on which the matter was originally scheduled.
7. Joliet Identified in Case Caption: The case caption for all Springer Brown matters shall state under the case number “DuPage County Case to be Heard in Joliet.”
8. Notice of the Change in Hearing Date, Time and Place: All Springer Brown matters currently scheduled for hearing in DuPage County must be renoticed for hearing in Joliet as follows:

A. New Motions must be Renoticed by Moving Party:

For all new motions involving Springer Brown, the **movant must file and serve new notices of motion** setting the motion for presentment at the appropriate time on a third Friday of the month in Joliet.

B. Continued and Set Matters will be Renoticed by the Court:

For all Springer Brown matters previously set or continued by court order, the court will issue orders resetting the matters for hearing in Joliet on a third Friday of the month.


C. Adversary Proceedings - Alias Summons:

If a summons issued in an adversary proceeding involving Springer Brown requires appearance in DuPage County, the plaintiff must serve an alias summons for an appropriate date in Joliet.

9. Emergencies: For cause, emergency motions involving Springer Brown (e.g., motions to extend the automatic stay) may be noticed for hearing in Joliet on a Friday other than the third Friday of the month.

10. Trials: If an adversary proceeding or contested matter involving Springer Brown must be set for trial, it will be reassigned for trial in Chicago.
